Greetings from the Exodus International office! Thank you for your interest in becoming a part of the Exodus Church Association. We would be delighted to receive your church as an applicant.

After 30 years of reaching out to individuals and families affected by homosexuality, Exodus recognizes the crucial need to work more closely with churches. Alan Chambers, the President of Exodus, commented, "Exodus is a Kingdom ministry—it is no longer a ministry outside of the church, but a ministry of the church."

Through our Church Association we hope to do three things. One, we hope to exhort the church at-large to stand confidently and boldly on the truth of scripture with regard to homosexuality. Two, we hope to equip churches to minister to the individuals within their own congregation who are struggling with unwanted homosexuality, as well as the family members of a gay loved one. And three, we hope to create a nationwide referral list of churches, including your church, for those who are searching for a church family that will walk alongside them in their journey. For men and women overcoming homosexuality, a pivotal part of healing and restoration is the need to be included in—and be a part of—the body of Christ. One woman overcoming lesbianism shared, "My experience of being welcomed, invited and embraced by the men, women, and families in my church made all the difference in the world as I sought to overcome my sexual brokenness and sin."

Included in this packet are a Letter for Potential ECA Pastors, Exodus' Doctrinal and Policy Statements, the Exodus Church Association Qualifications, the Application Form, ECA FAQ's and miscellaneous application information. Once you submit the application, it will be reviewed and, if all qualifications are met, your church will be listed as a part of the Exodus Church Association on the Exodus websites (www.exodusinternational.org and www.exoduschurchassociation.org) and will be a part of our in-house referral reports.

Letter to Pastors

Dear Potential ECA Pastor,

Greetings from the Exodus International office! Thank you for your interest in becoming a part of the Exodus Church Association. We would be delighted to receive your church as an applicant.

Your partnership with Exodus International is essential to our mission to mobilize the Body of Christ to minister grace and truth to a world impacted by homosexuality. **The Exodus Church Association is a referral network of caring communities sharing a common cause.** These churches share a redemptive biblical worldview on the issue of homosexuality and are committed to being safe places of worship for those dealing with unwanted same-sex attractions.

For your convenience, we have compiled a list of frequently asked questions given to us by pastors. We hope this will be beneficial in your consideration of membership in the Exodus Church Association.

What does it mean to be an Exodus Church Association Church?

If accepted, your church will appear on our national referral network listed on the Exodus International website. When someone who has been impacted by the issue of homosexuality (struggler, family member, friend) calls the Orlando office looking for local assistance, we will provide them with the closest Exodus Member Ministry, Counselor, and/or Church, depending upon their specific request and need. They will be provided with the contact information you have provided for your church. If they choose, they will make contact with the contact person you have designated.

What is expected once a referral makes contact?

Once a referral connects with your designated contact person, the contact person will be responsible for helping the referral become integrated in your church community. The contact person provides information such as service times, available ministries, counseling opportunities, small group opportunities, and fellowship events. We encourage the contact person to make a personal connection with the referral and help them to embrace the church community.

Is the contact person expected to provide counseling?

No. This is not a requirement for the church contact person. However, we do encourage the contact person to provide ministry and prayer to those who are referred.

Are we expected to have a ministry that is specific to the issue of homosexuality?

No! Please don't let this hinder you from joining the association. We do not require nor do we expect your church to have a ministry that specifically addresses homosexuality. In fact, our primary concern is that your church is committed to **providing foundational discipleship** to those who are referred to your church. Many have found freedom from homosexuality by becoming part of life-giving churches committed to raising up mature disciples in Christ. If your church is accepted, you will be provided with information about the closest Exodus Member Ministry and/or Counselor. We recommend that you work in partnership with these ministries in providing ministerial care to referrals. In the event that a Member Ministry and/or Counselor are not within your area, we will provide online resource and phone counseling alternatives.

What is the Pastoral Contact Person?

The pastoral contact person is responsible for providing oversight to the church contact person. In the event that the church contact person is no longer serving in this capacity or a part of your church community, the pastoral contact person is responsible for filling the church contact person position. The pastoral contact person simply serves as the direct representative of the pastoral staff and is contacted only by the Exodus staff and only when necessary.

Will the referral be told what to expect?

Yes. We will make the referral aware of what they can expect from an Exodus Church Association Member. A Referral FAQ sheet will be given to the referral and is provided in this packet.

How do I minister to someone dealing with homosexuality?

The same way you minister to the person dealing with fornication, adultery, gossip, etc. This is not meant to over-simplify; each struggle does have its unique challenges. However, God's truth applies to all situations and His Word is "profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16-17) The Corinthian Church had within its midst the sexually immoral, idolaters, adulterers, homosexuals, thieves, the greedy, drunkards, revilers, and swindlers. But 1 Corinthians 6 tells us "such **were** some of you." The Church is equipped to minister the truth of His Word to all forms of brokenness.

In addition, as part of your association with Exodus, we will provide discounted access to all of our books, resources, training materials, and conferences. These will be of great assistance in learning the nuances of ministry to those affected by homosexuality.

What are the benefits of joining?

By becoming a member of the Exodus Church Association, your church will be listed as a referral church on the Exodus website. You will also receive promotional materials, newsletters, and information regarding educational opportunities and resources. In addition, your church will be eligible for discounts when attending Exodus Freedom Conferences and a 10% discount when ordering resources from Exodus Books. These benefits and the opportunity to be connected with other ministries, counselors, and churches committed to proclaiming freedom from homosexuality is what makes membership worthwhile.

DOCTRINAL AND POLICY STATEMENTS

DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the inspired Word of God, the final authority for doctrine, reproof, correction and instruction in right living.
- We believe in one God, existing eternally in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, fully man and fully God, only-begotten Son of the Father. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and lived a sinless life. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, buried, and rose physically from the dead. He ascended to the right hand of the Father and will come again in power and glory.
- We believe that faith alone in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord frees us from the mastery of sin, and its consequences of death and eternal damnation. He assumed the penalty of death Himself, and enables us to live out of His resurrected life unto eternity.
- We believe the Holy Spirit carries out this work of renewal in our lives, empowering us to grow in loving union with our Heavenly Father and to walk in obedience to His will.
- We believe that the Church of Jesus Christ is formed of all those who know Him as their Savior and Lord, regardless of denominational beliefs.

POLICY STATEMENT

- Exodus International is a Christian organization dedicated to equipping and uniting agencies and individuals to effectively communicate the message of liberation from homosexuality, as well as how to effectively convey support and understanding to individuals facing the reality of a homosexual loved one.
- Exodus upholds heterosexuality as God's creative intent for humanity, and subsequently views homosexual expression as outside of God's will. Exodus cites homosexual tendencies as one of many disorders that beset fallen humanity. Choosing to resolve these tendencies through homosexual behavior, taking on a homosexual identity, and involvement in the homosexual lifestyle is considered destructive, as it distorts God's intent for the individual and is thus sinful.
- Instead, Christ offers a healing alternative to those with homosexual tendencies. Exodus upholds redemption for the homosexual person as the process whereby sin's power is broken, and the individual is freed to know and experience true identity as discovered in Christ and His Church. That process entails the freedom to grow into heterosexuality.
- Central to this redemption is Exodus' desire to unite and equip the Church to carry out this healing process. Exodus bridges the gap between Christians who respond to homosexual men and women with ignorance and fear, and those who uphold homosexuality as a valid, Christ-centered lifestyle. To Exodus, both extremes fail to convey to the homosexual the fullness of redemption found in Christ – He who embodies grace and truth, and invites us to partake of Him.

EXODUS CHURCH ASSOCIATION QUALIFICATIONS

The requirements for becoming and remaining a member in the Exodus Church Association are as follows:

- The church, including its leadership personnel and church statements of faith, must be in agreement with the Exodus doctrinal and policy statements.
- The church contact person for this area of ministry must have a minimum of three years without immoral sexual behavior and meet Biblical standards of leadership.
- The church contact person for this area of ministry must be an active participant in the church, with ongoing personal and spiritual accountability at the church.
- The church must appoint a Pastoral Contact Person. This person is a member of the church pastoral team and is responsible for overseeing the church contact person. The pastoral contact will reassign the church contact person position if necessary. They will serve as the first point of contact if the church contact person position becomes vacant.
- The church must notify the Exodus Church Association Director of any changes in either the pastoral contact person or the church contact person.
- The church must have been in existence for at least two years.
- The church must have a governing body in place.
- At least one representative overseeing this area of ministry within the church is highly encouraged to attend Exodus' International Conference at least once every three years.
- Once Church Association status is granted, a church must submit an annual renewal with any updated information. This renewal will be due on the anniversary date of Association Membership.
- Association Members are required to pay an annual \$50 administration fee.
- ECA Members agree with and utilize ministry and professional resources that are in agreement with Exodus standards. Members also agree to consult with Exodus concerning potential ministerial affiliation with individuals and/or organizations that promote ministry approaches in conflict with Exodus standards. Ministries and counseling methodologies that are not congruent with Exodus standards include but are not limited to:
 - Holding/Touch Therapy
 - Bioenergetic Therapy
 - Aversion Therapy

Association FAQ's

What is an Exodus Church Association Member?

An Exodus Church Association Member is part of a growing network of churches that have expressed a commitment to stand on the truth of Scripture with regard to homosexuality and have a desire to minister to people in their congregations who are impacted by homosexuality. Association churches agree that homosexual activity goes against God's design of sexuality. They do not reject individuals with same-sex attractions, nor do they encourage people to accept their homosexuality. Instead, Exodus Association Churches are places where people are free to share their struggle and where anyone impacted by homosexuality is welcomed into the fellowship of believers in the Church. Exodus Church Association Members need not have special support groups or ministries dealing specifically with homosexuality. All that is required of Association Members is that the church stands on the truth of Scripture and is willing to express love to people impacted by homosexuality.

What are the requirements for the Exodus Church Association?

Exodus Church Association Applicants must complete an application with Exodus International and meet the following requirements:

1. The Church must express agreement with Exodus' doctrinal and policy statements.
2. The Church must designate a church contact person and a pastoral contact for this area of ministry, and that contact person and anyone else in the leadership of this ministry must be free from immoral sexual behavior for a minimum of three years.
 - a. Church Contact Person – this person serves as a liaison between Exodus and the ECA church. They are responsible for assisting the referral to become familiar with church structure, ministry, and opportunities.
 - b. Pastoral Contact – this person is a member of the church pastoral team and is responsible for overseeing the church contact person. The pastoral contact will reassign the contact person position if necessary. They will serve as the first point of contact should the contact person position become vacant.
3. The Church must have a governing body in place.
4. The Church must have been in existence for at least two years.
5. Exodus strongly recommends that a representative of the Church attend the annual Exodus International Freedom Conference at least once every three years.
6. ECA Members are required to pay an annual \$50 administration fee.

What are the benefits of the Exodus Church Association?

1. ECA Members will be listed as an Exodus Church Association referral church on the Exodus website and promotional materials.
2. ECA Members will receive Exodus promotional materials, newsletters, and information regarding educational opportunities and resources.



3. ECA Members are eligible for a discount for Exodus Regional Conferences and Exodus International Freedom Conferences.
4. ECA Members are eligible for a 10% discount when ordering resources from Exodus Books.
5. Association members are eligible to participate in Exodus councils or task forces.
6. Connection with existing Exodus Member Ministries in your area
7. Periodic special equipping and training materials
8. Local mini-conferences and seminars (when made available)

Is being an Exodus Church Association Member going to take a lot of time?

All that is asked of ECA Churches is that they designate a contact person for this area of ministry. The contact person will be the person with whom the national Exodus Office communicates, but will also be the name given to people who are referred to your church (although personal contact information will not be released). The contact person will be responsible for sharing information about the church with the referral and helping him or her to connect with the church.

We encourage churches to find people within their church who have a heart for people impacted by homosexuality (including strugglers, friends and families). This ministry need not be demanding on church staff and can be a great opportunity for church members to discover a special place to use their hearts and gifts.

We don't know much about homosexuality or how to help people struggling with homosexuality. Can we still be a part of the Exodus Church Association?

YES! While specific ministries for people impacted by homosexuality and Christian counselors specializing in sexual issues can and do play a great role in ministry, the local church has amazing healing potential within the basic community of believers assembled there. Exodus believes in the healing power that comes through the Body of Christ and is represented in the local church. We firmly believe those impacted by homosexuality can find vital healing in simply being accepted and included in a Christian community.

In order to help the church better understand some of the issues surrounding homosexuality, and to help them better understand the needs of those impacted by homosexuality, Exodus will provide ECA Churches with many important resources, including but not limited to the following:

- A monthly letter containing important and pertinent information regarding homosexuality and ministry
- Lists of resources and highlights of new or updated resources
- Connection with existing Exodus Member Ministries in your area
- Training workshops at the annual Exodus International Freedom Conference
- Periodic special equipping and training materials
- Local mini-conferences and seminars (when made available)



How can we know that we will be associated with reputable churches and ministries?

The Exodus network is comprised of Member Ministries, Therapists and Churches. The requirements for all network members vary slightly, but every network member must agree with Exodus' doctrinal and policy statements. Exodus International strives to maintain the integrity, reputation and accountability of all network members.

Are there risks associated with affiliating with Exodus?

Unfortunately, those who seek to affirm homosexuality sometimes attack those who hold to the truth of Scripture, with regard to homosexuality. While the risk is minute, it is possible that your church could receive hateful mail, email or publicity with regard to your affiliation with Exodus. It is our prayer that you will see the benefit of ministering to those affected by homosexuality as worth any of the possible risks of retaliation or retribution.

Our Church has an affiliation with an Exodus Member Ministry. How does that impact our inclusion in the Exodus Church Association?

Any church that is affiliated with a member ministry can be automatically included in the Exodus Church Association. Because some people do not desire to have a specific ministry or a support group, we encourage such churches to be a part of the Exodus Church Association. Being a part of the Church Association will allow the church to minister to those who simply want a church that is true to Scripture, that believes in the life changing power of Christ and that fosters true relationships and real community.

What is the difference between an Exodus Member Ministry and an Exodus Church Association Church?

Exodus Member Ministries offer specific programs designed to help people overcome homosexuality and to help families impacted by the homosexual struggle of friends or family. These specific programs can include support groups and/or lay counseling for such specific areas as men and women overcoming homosexuality, parents whose child is living homosexually, spouses of those struggling with homosexuality, people impacted by HIV/AIDS, pornography or sexual addiction, and other related areas. While some of these ministries operate under the covering of a church, most are para-church ministries. Many of the leaders of the Exodus Member Ministries have either walked away from homosexuality themselves, or have friends or families involved in homosexuality to some degree.

Because of the sensitive nature of the specific ministry provided by Exodus Member Ministries, Exodus has extensive requirements in place for all Exodus Member Ministries, including guidelines for what types of programs can be offered, the required structure and authority of the Board of Directors, mandatory training and conference attendance and accountability to the Exodus office.

Exodus Association Churches are simply churches deemed by Exodus to be safe and sound places for people struggling with unwanted homosexual feelings, or anyone adversely impacted by homosexuality, to receive truth and grace as they deal with this issue in their lives, and as they pursue the Lord in the midst of their struggle.

ECA Referral FAQs

What can I expect from an Exodus Church Association Member Church?

ECA Churches are committed to display the grace and truth of Christ to those impacted by homosexuality. ECA Churches are in agreement with Exodus Doctrinal and Policy Statements that promote a redemptive view on the issue of homosexuality. They are caring communities sharing a common cause.

- *Exodus does not endorse or promote specific ministries of Association Churches that are not part of the Exodus Member Ministry Network.*

Will they have a support group, ministry, or counselor that ministers specifically to those dealing with unwanted same-sex attractions?

Association Churches are not required to have a ministry or counselor that ministers specifically to the issue of same-sex attractions. The primary purpose of member churches is to provide loving communities committed to walk with the same-sex struggler in their process of healing and help those we refer grow in their relationship with Christ by providing foundational discipleship. Many have found freedom from homosexuality by becoming part of life-giving churches committed to raising up mature disciples in Christ.

What can I expect from the church contact person?

The church contact person is responsible for providing you with the necessary information to become integrated within the church community. They will provide you with information on service times, directions, available ministries, counseling, service opportunities, available small groups, and fellowship events. The church contact person is committed to provide initial ministry and prayer but does not necessarily provide ongoing counseling. He or she will assist in providing any available information regarding ministry specific to same-sex attractions.

What if the ECA Church that I'm referred to does not have ministry specific to my struggle with same-sex attraction?

We can provide you with contact information for the nearest Exodus Member Ministry or Professional Counselor. In the event that neither of these options are within your area, we can provide you with online support resources and/or phone counseling opportunities. Exodus believes in the complimentary partnership of a church, member ministry, and/or counselor in the healing process. Remember, you are responsible for your freedom and no one else. Be committed to implement all available resources at your disposal rather than rely on just one.
